1 Corinthians 11:2-16

BIG IDEA: Authentic Churches recognize God's ordained authority in their lives.

"I want you to know that Christ is the head of every man, and the man is the head of the woman, and God is the head of Christ." 1 Corinthians 11:3 (CSB)

OBSERVATIONS:

- Authority derives from <u>redemptive</u> <u>relationships</u>.
- Authority derives from <u>creation's order</u>.
- o Authority derives from nature's pattern.

LESSONS:

- O There is a distinction between men & women.
- o There is <u>equality</u> between <u>men</u> & <u>women</u>.
- There are unique <u>responsibilities</u> for <u>men</u> & <u>women</u>.

o Women are honored.

BIG IDEA: Authentic Churches recognize God's ordained authority in their lives.

Read: Re-read 1 Corinthians 11:2-16.

Think: Consider Paul's discussion about authority, and then ask yourself the following questions: What are the Corinthians doing wrong? What "theological" reasons does Paul provide for understanding the lines of authority God ordained? What "cultural" reasons? Is a head-covering a permanent need for women? Why or why not?

Do: Concern for the glory and authority of God, the interdependence of men and women and sensitivity to the culture are three principles emphasized here. Whether you are a man or woman, how will you apply these principles in your life this week?
