FATHER'S DAY!

Psalm 78:1-8

BIG IDEA: Faithful fathers guide their families on the journey of life.

"Start a youth out on his way; even when he grows old he will not depart from it" Proverbs 22:6 (CSB)

- Faithful fathers know they have to <u>start</u> with the <u>right directions</u>. (v1-10)
 - o Listen to the right directions.
 - o Look at the right directions.
 - <u>Learn</u> to <u>follow</u> the <u>right directions</u>.
- Faithful fathers know those who've gone <u>before</u> us help <u>blaze</u> the <u>trail</u> for those who come <u>behind</u> us.

 (v11-20)
 - O Remember, the past informs the present.
 - O Remember, the <u>present</u> informs the <u>future</u>.
- Faithful fathers know how to stay off <u>dead</u> ends and avoid <u>road</u> <u>hazards</u>. (v21-30)
 - Stay off the path of stubbornness.

- Stay off the <u>path</u> of <u>rebelliousness</u>.
- Stay off the path of fickleness.
- O Stay off the path of unfaithfulness.

BIG IDEA: Faithful fathers guide their families on the journey of life.

READ: Psalm 78:1-8

THINK: Consider the impact of fathers indicated in these verses, then ask yourself these questions: Who is the keeper of your family stories and traditions? Do you ever hear of times when your folks or grandparents were young? What "warning to the future generations" is implicit in their oft-repeated stories? What does the psalmist want future generations to know and "not forget" about God? Why? What would happen if the next generations do forget? Whose responsibility is it to see that they remember?

DO: Dad, what are your children and grandchildren learning from your life story? What godly, righteous life-lessons do you want to pass along to the next generations?
