BIG IDEA: This Christmas, God wants to give me real peace.

"He will be named...the Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:6 (CSB)

- The <u>Character</u> of the <u>Prince</u> of <u>Peace</u>.
 - Jesus is the ultimate <u>Ruler</u>.
 - Jesus is the personification of <u>peace</u>.

- The Conduct of the Prince of Peace.
 - o Jesus provides peace with God.
 - Jesus provides the <u>peace</u> of <u>God</u>.
 - Jesus provides <u>peace</u> with <u>others</u>.

BIG IDEA: This Christmas, God wants to give me real peace.

Read: Re-read Isaiah 9:1-7.

Think: Reflect on Jesus Christ as the Prince of Peace, and then ask yourself the following questions: What sets Jesus apart from any other ruler? What is different about Jesus' peace than that offered to us by the world? What was it like when you were at war with God? What does it mean to you that you can have peace with God through Jesus Christ? Describe how you have experienced the peace of God in your life? How has God allowed you to be a peacemaker?

Do: Be sure you know "The God of peace" so you have "peace with God" and can experience the "peace of God". Who might you need to extend an olive branch to in order to be a peacemaker? Take the God-step and offer peace to others.
