BIG IDEA: The Church is a BUILDING; the goal is QUALITY.

"You are God's building." 1 Corinthians 3:9b (CSB)

- Build in the <u>right place</u>. (v10, 11)
  - $\circ$  Lay the right foundation.
  - The <u>foundation</u> is <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u>.
- Build with the <u>right</u> crew. (v9, 10b, 16-17)
  - o Members only.
  - o <u>Each</u> member.
  - o <u>All</u> members.
- Build with the right plan. (v10, 18-20)
  - Build like an architect.
  - Build with great care.
- Build with the <u>right</u> materials. (v12)
  - What to <u>use</u>.

• What <u>NOT</u> to <u>use</u>.

- Build for the <u>right reasons</u>. (v12-15, 21-23)
  Why I <u>build</u> will be <u>revealed</u>.
  - Why I build will be rewarded.

BIG IDEA: The Church is a BUILDING; the goal is QUALITY.

## READ: 1 Corinthians 3:9b-23; Matthew 7:24-27

**THINK**: Consider the Church as a Building, then ask yourself these questions: *As a metaphor, how would you describe yourself in terms of a building: a skyscraper, grass shack, bomb shelter, greenhouse, or what? Why? What is the point of Paul's extended metaphor about the Church as a building in v10-15? How is Jesus the foundation? How do believers go about the building process in Christ's Church? What building materials should we be using to build the Church? How is each person's work tested? Why?* 

**DO**: Given the clues about what makes for good "building materials", what is one "concrete" way you could help build God's Church right here and right now at WBC?
